- Online nomination period opens **April 24th and closes May 27th, 2022**. No submission deadline extensions will be permitted.
- Recipient will be announced across WGF social media platforms on **June 15th, 2022**.
- The site for the 2022 in-person ceremony - **Pro Football Hall of Fame stadium in Canton, Ohio, WFA Championship weekend, July 8 – 9th, 2022**.
- Recipient to be chosen by formal vote of the WGF Board of Directors and Advisors.
- **\$500** donation to the recipient's charity of choice.
- Each year's recipient and all nominees will be listed on the Women's Gridiron Foundation website in perpetuity.
- 2022 award - restricted to tackle teams in the continental United States.
- An additional, International Woman of the Year Award to launch in 2023

### **Submission Requirements and Instructions – READ CAREFULLY**

- The team / organization must be a member – in **good standing\*** - of a fully operational women's league and competing in that respective league's 2022 season.
- Only one player per team may be nominated
- Online form submission **MUST** and **ONLY** be completed by one of the following: **Team Owner, Head Coach, or Team Manager**
